Health Center Management

Our **health centers**, both CSR Somika and Lupoto Clinic, continued to be pillars of support, recording a total of **5,604** service utilizations for local communities, including **prenatal** and **curative consultations**, as well **vaccinations** administered to newborns and mothers.

Plugged-In Program

Plugged-In saw 147 beneficiaries with students receiving certificates:

- For the Jan. to June 2023 session, 69 students registered and 44 were certified from both Notre Dame du Travail and Groupe Scolaire Charitable.
- In the Oct. 2023 to June 2024 session, **289 students** registered, and **103** are currently undergoing the program.

Additionally, **6 teachers** of the Plugged-In Program have been under training during September.



English Program initiatives

This program aims to empower students through an english proficiency, fostering holistic development.

Enrolled: 199 students

Certified: 29 students (not including ongoing sessions)

Notre Dame du Travail (Somika Kipushi)

- Jan. to April 2023 session: 20 students enrolled, and an impressive
 16 successfully passed.
- Oct. 2023 to June 2024 session: A remarkable **76** students registered, in the currently ongoing batch.

Seleyi School (Somika Lupoto)

- Apr. to July 2023 session: Witnessing active engagement, **30 students** enrolled, with 13 successfully certified.
- Oct23 to Feb24 session: Currently underway, **43 students** registered, and **13** are actively progressing.

Kipopo School

Oct. 2023 to Feb. 2024 session: An enthusiastic cohort of **30 students** has registered, eagerly working towards certification pending successful test completion.

Teachers Training Programs

Equipped 20 educators at Lupoto schools with enhanced teaching methodologies.

Our program enabled 13 students to pursue higher education, partnering with reputable universities like Symbiosis and UNH. Here's the institution-wise break-up:

3 at MSU, **4** at Symbiosis University in India; **4** at UNH University in Lubumbashi and **1** at Kolwezi University in Kolwezi.

Borewells implementation

Our commitment to community infrastructure materialized through the successful drilling of solar-powered borewells in Lupoto and Kimpe, providing essential water resources. Here's a location-wise break-up:

Road Rehabilitation Program

The **Road Rehabilitation initiative**, covering **22 km** around Somika Kipushi, not only improved connectivity but also symbolized progress.





Schools Renovated for 2023-2024 Scholar Year

The rehabilitation of Seleyi Primary School at Lupoto and Lukangaba Primary School at KIMPE not only impacted approximately **600** students but also reflected our commitment to educational infrastructure enhancement. The rehabilitation of both schools consisted of exterior plastering, reconditioning of the pavement, exterior and interior painting, placement of the ceiling, fixing of doors and windows, and repair of sanitary facilities.









Inauguration of a new school

An equipped primary school including **6** classrooms, **1** administration bloc, and washrooms has been inaugurated at Kimpe on Nov. 04, 2023. Musoya Primary School will provide education to approx. **300** students.

All about Entrepreneurship of the Foundation

Agri-Projects

In the poultry sector, our Chicken Breeding initiative distributed **5,000** chicks, benefitting **228** entrepreneurs.

The Beekeeping Project, in partnership with Pact & USAID, supported **60** individuals.

Agriculture saw multifaceted growth, from distributing Irrigation Kits to facilitating market gardening as well as maize, soya, beans, and peanut cultivation across various regions, impacting hundreds of beneficiaries



We extended our support to approximately **280** farmers in **7** villages around Kimin; **297** farmers in **4** villages around Kimpe; **478** farmers in over **15** villages around Lupoto by donating seeds, fertilizers, insecticides, and agricultural equipment for the cultivation of Maize/Soya/Beans/Peanuts on a total of **200** hectares of land.

Through our market gardening, we supported approximately **69** farmers around Kimpe and **590** farmers around Kimin on a total of **65** hectares of land.



Open Markets

were organized at Lupoto, Kimpe, and Kimin to showcase the production of local farmers, promoting their businesses through our CSR entrepreneurship projects. The Open Day aims to connect farmers with vendors from nearby markets, fostering a network for mutual benefit. The focus of the presentation is on maize harvest and vegetable cultivation.

Financial Inclusion initiatives

In collaboration with the Equity Foundation, we have empowered local agri-entrepreneurs in Lupoto and Kimin. Our comprehensive approach includes financial education, access to financing, entrepreneurship training, and the establishment of bank accounts for farmers. By deploying banking agents in villages, we strengthen proximity to services, evaluate farmers' progress, and address financial and

During our collaboration, we successfully trained **200** farmers on essential financial tools such as Budgeting, Saving, Investing, and Business Administration. As a result, **111** farmers opened bank accounts for the first time, marking a significant step toward their financial inclusion.

Maison Amani Initiatives

Maison Amani benefitted from Back to School Kits (for their **60 girls**) and ongoing rehabilitation (external plastering, interior and exterior painting, door and window fixing) initiated by Vinmart Foundation through a contractor. Additionally, **2** girls received VMF scholarships at UNH University in Lubumbashi/DRC.

Jack Foundation Collaboration

Jack Foundation (146 primates): VMF's monthly contributions support groceries and medicines in their dispensary, contributing to the protection and care of 146 primates.

Education Partnerships

Notre Dame du Travail (NDT) & Institut Technique de Kisanga (ITK): Monthly subsidisation of school fees for **400** students, promoting access to quality education.

Old Age Home and Medical Support

Old Age Home (6 elderly): VMF's monthly contributions cover food, cleaning products, and general well-being. Free trimester medical consultations and support extended to 6 individuals at Old Age Home in Katuba, ensuring their well-being and comfort.
